Información específica: Seminar Content

According to the set objectives, the seminar content consists of three main modules, including Lectures, Officials Visits & Meetings and Discussions and Cultural Experience Activities.

I. Lectures:

1. Overview of China Basic Conditions: It mainly introduces the current situation of China's political, economic, social and cultural development and achievements since the founding of New China 75 years ago and the reform and opening up 46 years ago.
2. The Belt and Road Initiative and China's Economy: It mainly introduces the Belt and Road Initiative, the development history of China's economy and its current characteristics.
3. China's Poverty Reduction Policies and Practices: The course systematically introduces China's poverty reduction science and explains China's poverty reduction practices from the perspective of political economy. The course analyses China's poverty reduction measures and correct experiences with examples.
4. Chinese Foreign Policy: It mainly introduces the policy regulations related to Chinese diplomacy, as well as China's diplomatic means and ways of dealing with diplomacy in the diplomatic process.
5. International Protocol and Etiquette: It mainly introduces the norms and taboos of Chinese etiquette in diplomatic occasions and environments.
6. Intercultural Communication: It mainly introduces the definition of intercultural communication, understands the differences between Chinese and Western cultures, and helps the students to construct the real scene of intercultural communication through the cases of obstacles encountered in the process of intercultural communication as well as the cases of successful intercultural communication.
7. Chinese Festival Culture: Through understanding the culture behind the festivals, students can feel the unique traditional festival culture of China.
8. Chinese paper-cutting culture: mainly introduces the history, culture and classification of Chinese paper-cutting, and adopts a combination of physical display and practical practice demonstration to learn the basic techniques of Chinese paper-cutting step by step.

9. Chinese Peking Opera culture: mainly introduces the development history of Chinese Peking Opera, the four major trades, the representative characters of each school, while hands-on experience of Peking Opera face painting.

10. Chinese tea culture: let the participants understand the basic knowledge of tea, the development and evolution of Chinese tea culture and the spiritual connotation, master the general knowledge of tea utensils, the correct use of tea etiquette.

II. Officials Visits & Meetings and Discussions:

We will organize field trips to Beijing and Weihai to exchange with government agencies, enterprises and institutions in different fields, so that participants can experience China's development first-hand and gain an in-depth understanding of China's development model and experience.

III. Cultural Experience Activities:

In addition to the lectures and exchanges, we will also organize visits to famous historical and cultural sites in Beijing and Weihai, so that the participants can experience first-hand the profoundness of Chinese culture and social development.

We hope, through this seminar, the participants will not only experience Chinese language and culture, but also know more about China, so as to promote the cooperation between China and the Belt and Road countries and lay a solid foundation for further exchanges and cooperation.
